The **Community Engagement Programme**

(CEP) is an innovative partnership between Safer London Foundation, the Metropolitan Police Authority and the Metropolitan Police Service, to provide support and information to Safer Neighbourhoods Panel Members and Community and Police Engagement Groups throughout London.

The CEP provides participants with:

- information sharing in areas of common interest
- opportunities for sharing good practice and networking
- an e-learning option i.e. a CD-ROM containing all the material delivered at the seminars
- guidance on developing opportunities for local volunteering and community representation by promoting and recruiting to the Panels
- e-newsletter
- master classes

Over 128 seminars will be held across the 32 Boroughs targeting the Safer Neighbourhoods Panel Chairs (or their representatives) and 32 Community Police Engagement Groups.
